



## **“Spirited Conversations” to open at Stutz Art Space Gallery Nov. 7**

INDIANAPOLIS (Oct. 10, 2008) – As part of the 13<sup>th</sup> annual Spirit & Place Festival, nine visual artists from the Stutz will explore the theme of artistic and spiritual dialogue in a group show called “Spirited Conversations” that opens Nov. 7.

Participating artists are Susan Brewer, Janet Chilton, Jane Knight, Karen Land, Susan Mauck, Carol L. Myers, Kate Oberreich, Stephanie Lewis Robertson and Ginny Taylor Rosner.

“It has been very satisfying to link up with other artists who consider spirit an important part of their creative process,” said organizer Carol L. Myers. “The title of the show, ‘Spirited Conversations,’ can be interpreted in so many ways. It will be a delight to see how the nine artists invoke their muse and then continue the conversation with each other and the public, each in her own medium. The Stutz artist community is rich with conversation and art, and this will provide another layer of community and group conversation.”

The mission of the Festival is to stimulate conversation, collaboration, community-building and action based on the artistic, religious and civic traditions that make Central Indiana unique.

The show opens with a Nov. 7 reception from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m., in conjunction with the Indianapolis Downtown Artists & Dealers Association’s (IDADA) monthly First Friday gallery tour. The show runs through Nov. 21. The gallery is open from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. weekdays, or by appointment.

Stutz Art Space, a nonprofit visual art center, opened in January on the first floor of the Stutz Business Center. Its mission is to connect artists, audiences and resources. In that spirit, classes and workshops are designed to pair professional artists with students at a wide range of skill
